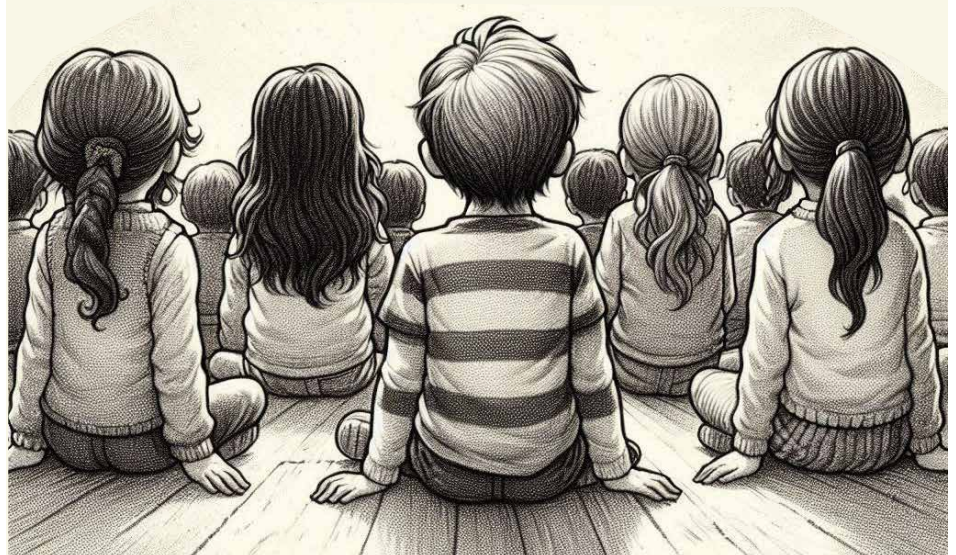

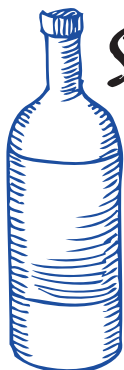


## opportunities to serve in september
