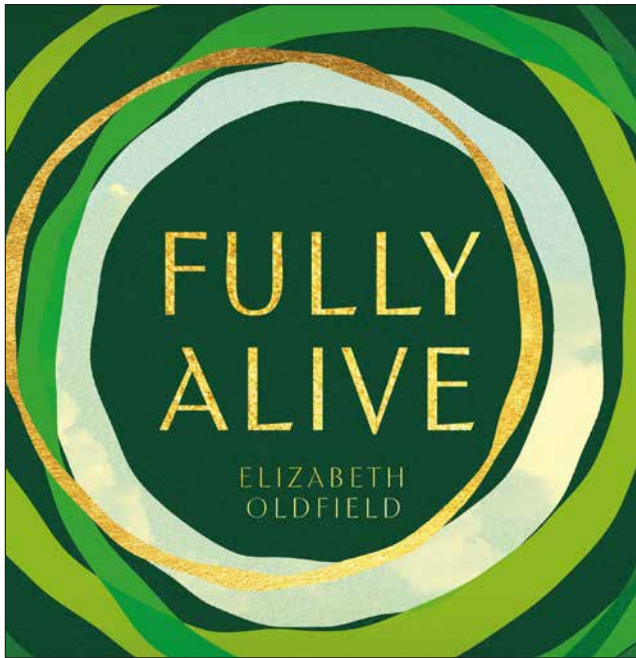


## Metropolitan Chamber Orchestra Concert

Starting next Sunday, 9:30, Parish Hall

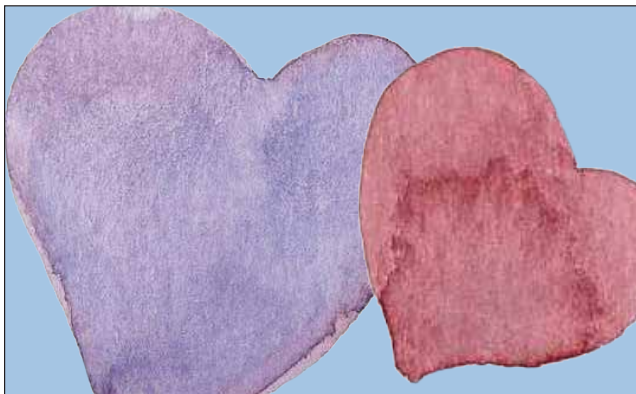


# CANDLEMAS
