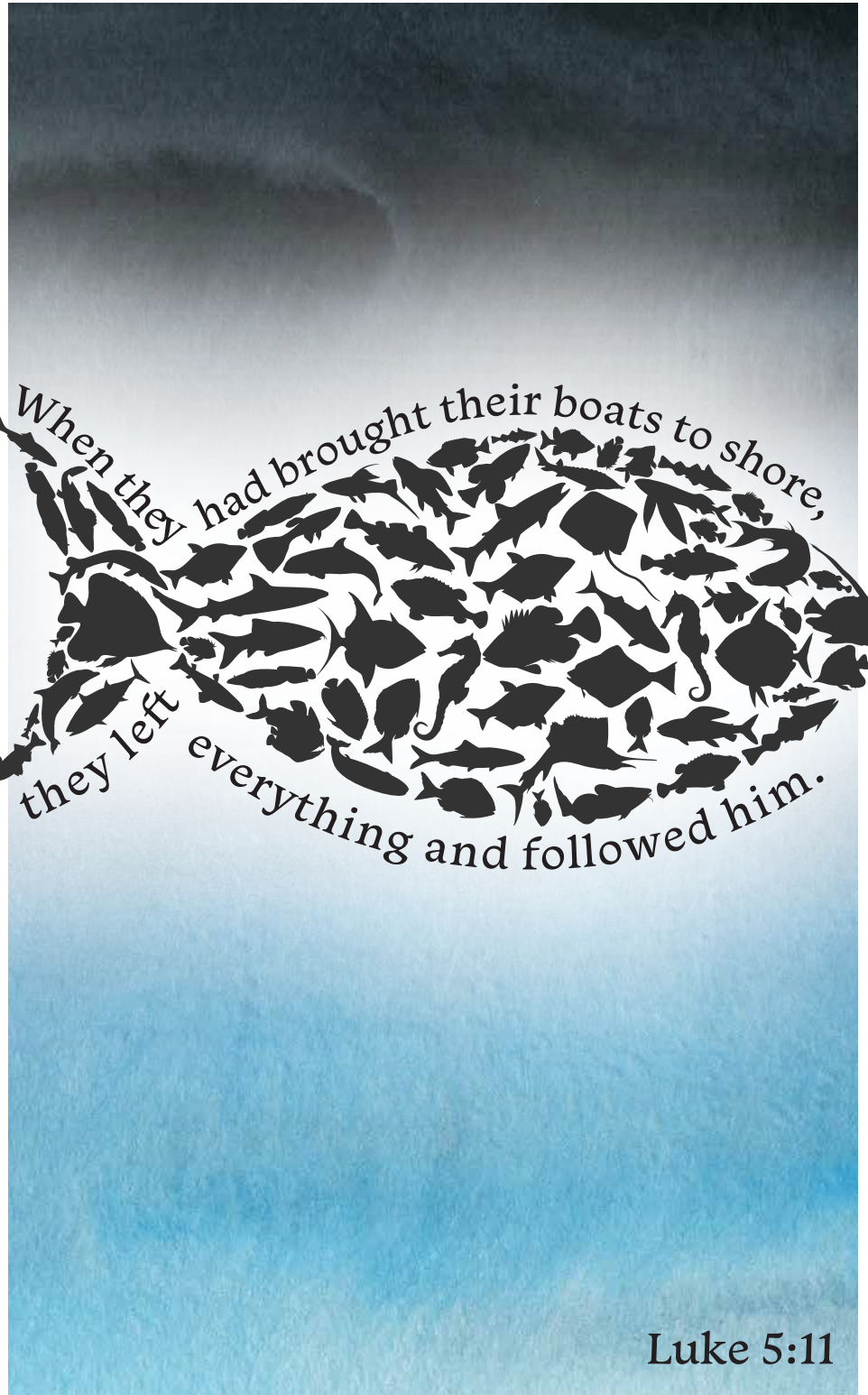

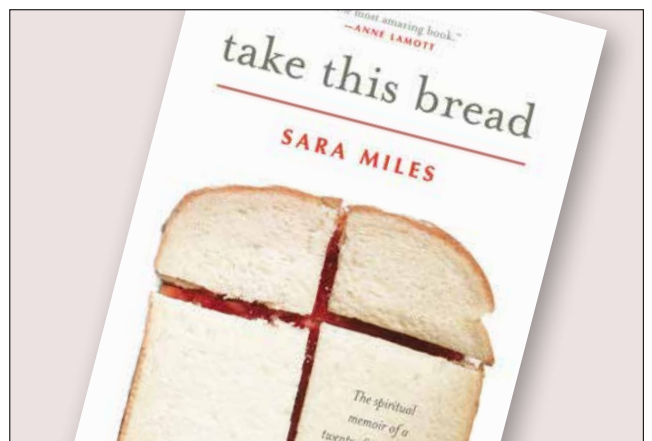
## Welcome Scouts!

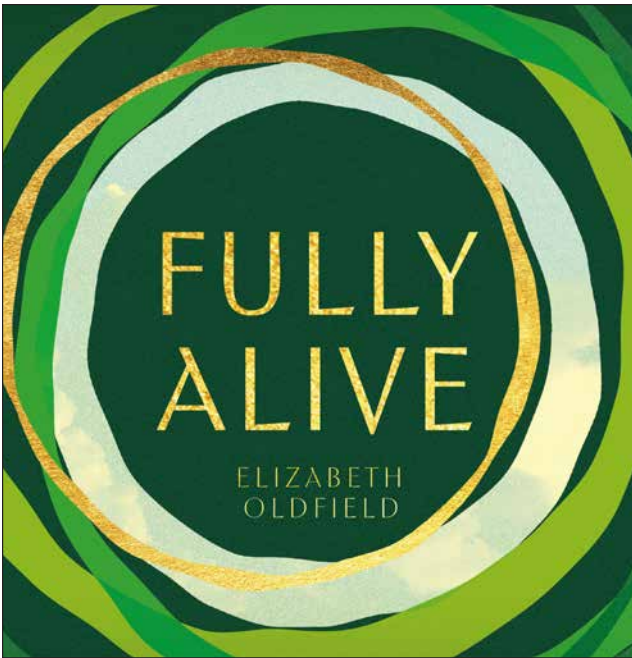

**through February 22nd - only a few spots left!**

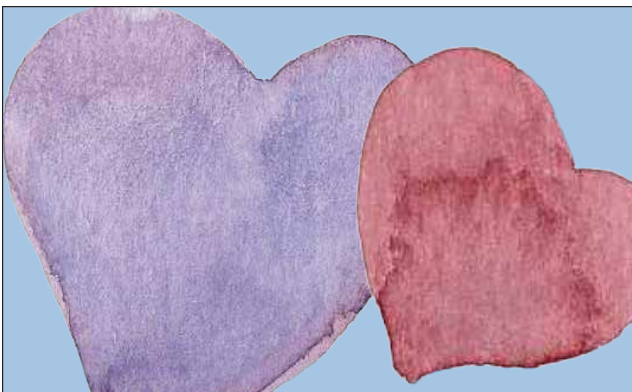
