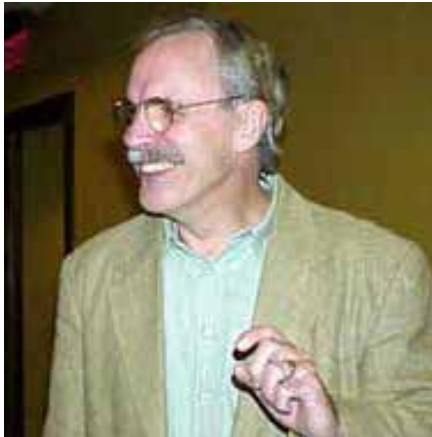


## Servant Sunday
