Would you like to be a part of an amazing community where you build relationships through sharing stories, worship and study.?

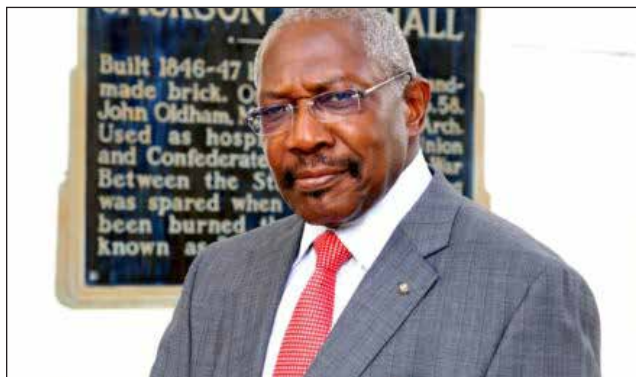
Well, here's your chance to study both the Old and New Testament, explore 3000 years of church history and gain a better understanding of the word theology.

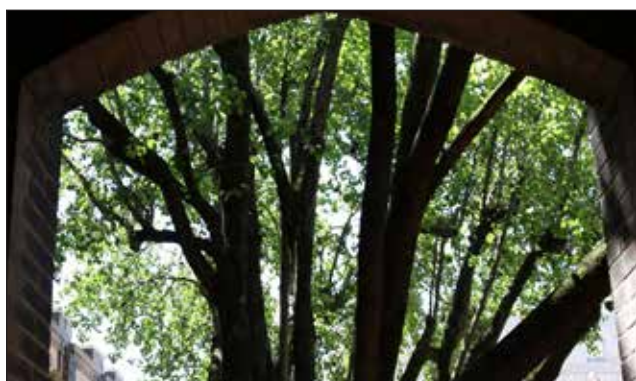

Visit from the mayor

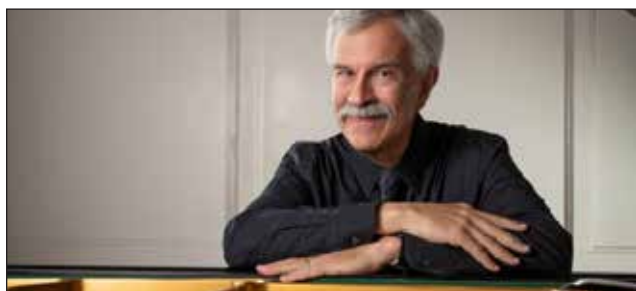
Sunday, August 24th, 9:30am

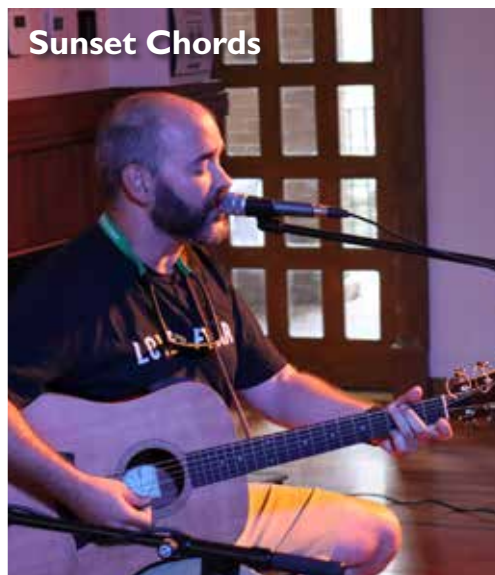
Godly Play Blessing
